Dear Parents,

August may seem like a long way off and that's a good thing right now because it gives you time to save for your child's summer camping experience at Hume Lake. Last year we had 20 GROW Zone kids attend camp at Hume Lake for the very first time. I was there with them all week and saw the amazing time and impact that Christian camping had on them. I'll be honest...we had a few homesick moments, but all in all the kids had an outstanding experience.

If your child will be age 8, 9, 10 or 11 by August 8th he or she may attend Wagon Train. Wagon Train is an elementary aged camp. Wagon Train provides quality meals, great recreational games and activities, dynamic Bible teaching, the experience of getting to know God, fellow campers and a top notch staff in the great outdoors.

The cost for Wagon Train is \$419. This includes transportation to and from camp, all meals and lodging while at camp, a trained counselor, recreation activities, chapels, tons of fun and memories to last a lifetime. In addition to this amount your child will need money to buy lunch on the way to camp and on the way home and some spending money while they are at camp.

I know this is a great expense. I can also tell you from firsthand experience with my own three kids that it is a phenomenal opportunity. In other words it is worth it! Scholarships are available from Hume Lake. Last year those who applied got as much as \$150. Gifts are given by church members and attenders. We will have at least one fund raiser. You may end up needing to contribute as much as half to $\frac{3}{4}$'s of the total cost. I know that the amount you contribute is much more manageable when spread out over the next seven months. For Wagon Train you could pay the total amount if you gave \$92.25 for May through August.

What is the next step? Register your child for camp by contacting me and filling out the online form that Hume Lake will send you. Give me a deposit of \$50. Continue giving me the monthly amount mentioned. I will notify you concerning scholarships given by Hume Lake, gifts made by church members and attenders and the amount raised by the fund raiser. Each of those will decrease the amount you owe.
