Job Position: Part-time Sound Technician (Paid)

Eagle Rock Baptist Church is searching for a Christian woman or man to run the sound system for church services, choral groups, theatre and similar events. The successful candidate can blend the technical and artistic aspects of mixing sound in a live venue, can delegate to and train volunteers with patience and understanding, has a positive attitude and previous work experience running sound for churches, and is willing to do a job that receives little glory but is very important. The abilities to work cooperatively in a team and take direction from a supervisor are expected. The Sound Technician will receive direct supervision from the Worship Director. A basic understanding of live sound and running a mixing console (analog or digital) is a must.

The primary job duty for this position is running sound on a mixing console for two weekend contemporary worship services (Saturday 5:30 PM and Sunday 11 AM) and one traditional worship service (Sunday 8:15 AM). Other job duties include (but are not limited to) setting up and tearing down the stage of microphones, cables and monitors, training volunteers, and setting up, running and tearing down of portable sound systems for special events.

The Sound Technician will be compensated at a rate of \$15.00 per hour for up to 10 hours per week. While a few of the hours are flexible, the Sound Technician is expected to work Saturday 3:00 PM - 7:00 PM and Sunday 9:00 AM -1:00 PM.
