LIFEGROUPS

QUICK REVIEW

Thinking back to the sermon this weekend “Godzilla King of the Monsters: Defeating the Monster Problems In My Life,” in a sentence or two summarize the main point.

Was there anything you heard for the first time or that caught your attention, challenged or confused you?

Is there any practical step you plan on taking this week in response to the message?

GETTING STARTED

➤ In the message this weekend, Pastor Andrew contrasted a response of faith with one driven by fear. What's something that you're afraid of that other people might think is silly?

➤ Have you ever experienced God's presence in the midst of a trial, problem, or scary situation? If so, what was it like?

DIGGING DEEPER

1. Hebrews chapter 11 is often called the “Hall of Faith.” In it, we see examples of men and women boldly stepping out in faith despite incredible circumstances. Who are your spiritual heroes, biblical or otherwise, who have faced challenges faithfully?

Read Hebrews 11:1-16. What do you think is the purpose of including this list of exemplary men and women of faith?

What stands out to you most in this passage?

Can you think of a time in your life when you stepped out in faith?

2. King David was no stranger to monster problems. Whether it was a giant, a king, or even members of his own family, David always seemed to be at the center of a storm. Read Psalm 27:1-14. What line or lines in this passage speak to you the most?

How do you think David came to be so trusting in the face of danger?

What difference do you think it would make to pray this prayer regularly?

Do you think it's possible to become as fearless as David in the face of trials and adversity? If so, how?

3. In Matthew 8:23-27 the disciples found themselves in a scary situation, trapped on a boat in the middle of a storm. Read the passage and imagine being in that situation. How do you think you have responded if you were on the boat?

What was it that enabled Jesus to remain so calm?

If the disciples' response evidenced little faith, what do you think a faithful response to the storm would have looked like?

What do you think it looks like to call out to Jesus faithfully in the midst of the storms of our lives?

Is there a storm in your life that you're currently facing that you would like to share with the group?

TAKING IT HOME

☞ Is there a promise that God has made that you need to remember in light of the monster problem you're facing?

☞ How can the group be an encouragement to you to see your problems through the lens of faith?
