Discussion Questions - Week #5

LIFFGROUPS

QUICK REVIEW

Thinking back to the sermon this weekend, "Jesus and the End Times," summarize the main point in a sentence or two.

Looking at your notes, was there anything you heard for the first time, caught your attention, challenged, or confused you?

Do you plan on taking any practical steps this week in response to the message?

GETTING STARTED

What is your typical response when you hear someone talking about the end times?

Popular culture today is filled with apocalyptic themes in movies, TV, and literature. What's your favorite example of this and why?

DIGGING DEEPER

. In this weekend's message, Pastor Rick shared, "When it comes to end times, Jesus wants us to focus not on our calendars but on our character." One passage that focuses on such character is found in Matthew 25:31-46. Read the passage together. What stands out to you?

What does this parable teach us about how Christ wants us to live in light of His return?

Who do you think are "the least" that Christ refers to?

In what ways do you practice the behaviors Jesus references in your life?

Which, if any, might be missing? Why?

How would you make sense of this parable in light of Paul's words in Ephesians 2:8-9?

2. Read 2 Timothy 3:1-16. In this passage, Paul tells Timothy what things will be like in the last days. Based on Paul's words, do you think the time is drawing near? Why or why not?

Do you think you are prone to focus too little or too much on the end?

What does Paul suggest should mark our lives in these times?

What point do you think Paul was trying to make by describing his own suffering in this section?

How does God's word equip us for Christ's return?

FOR PRACTICE

Sunday, May 19, is Pentecost Sunday. Set aside time this week to prayerfully reflect on John 14:15-31 and Acts 2. As you read these passages, consider the difference the Holy Spirit has made in your life. Then, offer God praise and thanksgiving for the wonderful gift of the Spirit and ask him to show you the areas in your life where you are resistant to his leading and to give you the ability to surrender.
