¹So then, since Christ suffered physical pain, you must arm yourselves with the same attitude he had, and be ready to suffer, too. For if you have suffered physically for Christ, you have finished with sin. ²You won't spend the rest of your lives chasing your own desires, but you will be anxious to do the will of God. ³You have had enough in the past of the evil things that godless people enjoy—their immorality and lust, their feasting and drunkenness and wild parties, and their terrible worship of idols. ⁴Of course, your former friends are surprised when you no longer plunge into the flood of wild and destructive things they do. So they slander you. ⁵But remember that they will have to face God, who stands ready to judge everyone, both the living and the dead. ⁵That is why the Good News was preached to those who are now dead—so although they were destined to die like all people, they now live forever with God in the Spirit.

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QUICK REVIEW

What can we do to increasingly live with more of Christ's mindset?

How do we pursue like-mindedness with someone we might disagree with?

What is one practical application you could put into place this week considering this passage?

2. Read Mark 2:13-17. What stands out to you in this passage?

Why do you think Jesus chose Levi to follow Him?

What did Levi stand to lose in choosing to follow Jesus?

What has it cost you to follow Jesus?

How did Levi demonstrate the right attitude toward discipleship?

If someone asked you, "What should I do to follow Jesus?" how would you respond?

FOR PRACTICE

The memory verse for this week speaks about the fact that our obedience is a sign of our love for God. While it is not often recognized, the practice of obedience is a Spiritual discipline known for impressing Christ's likeness onto our wayward selves. Take time this week to ask God to show you one small area that he would like you to turn over in obedience to Him. Then surrender it! The path to complete loving obedience begins with one small step today.
