## Discussion Questions - Week #7

# LIFEGROUPS

### QUICK REVIEW

Thinking back to the sermon this weekend "Sola Scriptura," in a sentence or two summarize the main point.

Looking back at your notes, was there anything you heard for the first time or that caught your attention, challenged or confused you?

### GETTING STARTED

1. Share with the group your favorite bible verse or bible passage and what it is about it that you appreciate so much.

2. In the message this weekend Pastor Andrew preached on the authority of scripture. What thoughts or feelings come to mind for you when you hear the word authority? Why do you think or feel that way?

### DIGGING DEEPER

3. Read Psalm 119:1-18. How would you describe the psalmist's perspective on God's word?

What does it mean to hide God's word in your heart?

How could hiding God's word in your heart prevent you from sinning?

What does it mean to take delight in God's decrees (v.16)?

Where do you think that delight comes from?

Do you think delight in God's way is something you can develop? If so, how?

4. Read 1 Peter 1:23, Romans 10:17, Psalm 119:105, and John 17:17. What are the different purposes of God's word according to these passages?

How have you seen these purposes play out in your life?

Why do you think some people will experience the results spoken of in these passages, while others may not?

What step could you take to allow God's word to bring about greater growth in your life?

5. Read Hebrews 4:12-13. What stands out to you in this passage?

Why do you think God's word is described as a sword?

How have you experienced God's word as living and active?

Do you think your experience with the word of God matches the description you find in this passage? Why or why not?

### TAKING IT HOME

6. What change or changes can you make this week to ensure that you're spending sufficient time in God's word?

7. How can the group be praying for you to surrender to God's authoritative word?
